TIMELY ACCESS TO CRITICAL INFORMATION

Premier MDC and Premier Handheld are wireless mobile data communication software solutions that give officers access quickly and securely to information about people, property and vehicles. This information can be accessed from the confines of their patrol cars or while on foot, bicycle, horseback or motorcycle patrol.

This technology enables officers to quickly obtain information which is normally retrieved via radio contact with a dispatch center, or that previously could not be accessed at all. The Premier MDC and Premier Handheld software give officers access to federal, state and local databases with an easy single entry check using advanced radio technology with compressed and encrypted data transmissions.

Driver's license information is captured using the 2D bar code scanner or magstripe reader allowing license information to appear on the mobile computer. A query can automatically be sent to the State/DMV and federal databases, including the National Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (NLETS) and the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) from the scanned license information. Officers no longer have to radio dispatch or travel to headquarters to obtain information, allowing them to remain in the field, protecting their community.

Premier MDC and Premier Handheld support silent dispatch and communication via a Computer Aided Dispatch system (CAD). Premier MDC provides a complete interface with Motorola's Premier CAD™ software, delivering critical information to field personnel. Key features provided with Premier MDC

and Premier CAD integration include: dispatch, current unit status, query hit notifications, silent emergency notifications, messaging, and address verifications.

OFFICER SAFETY


Premier MDC and Premier Handheld software are helping to fight crime with wireless technology which is playing an increasingly important role in tackling the issues of public safety today; giving officers first hand knowledge of a potential criminal or dangerous situation before making contact with an individual or suspect. When officers stop a vehicle, they are able enter the license plate number to obtain information about the vehicle and driver. Officers have the flexibility to query NLETS and the NCIC as well as a Record Management System (RMS). In less than a minute, officers have the latest information on the driver – license status, arrest warrants and more. This information can be critical to an officer who may suddenly be faced with a dangerous situation, which started out as a routine traffic stop.

SECURE TRANSMISSIONS

Premier MDC and Premier Handheld software provide for transmission of secure, detailed information from the Message Switch to field personnel. Transactions are encrypted using 128-bit Advanced Encryption Standard (AES) including, silent dispatches that allow officer status updates to effectively inform dispatch of their disposition.



The Premier Handheld application puts critical information right in the police officers' hands for faster, smarter and more efficient response.





The Dispatch window of Premier MDC software displays information sent to the mobile officer from the CAD. Officers can review the list of dispatches and then view details of a selected incident, including assigned units, weapon, vehicle and premise information.



The Premier Handheld main application screen provides access to all major functions with easily identifiable icons and descriptions.

The reality today is that voice radio traffic can interfere with the officer's requests and ability to communicate with other officers. The messaging feature of Premier MDC and Premier Handheld allows the officers to silently and securely exchange messages with anyone

connected to the Premier MDC system. This can include headquarters, dispatch, a supervisor or another police car. The system administrator can easily create messaging groups so that routing can be accomplished.
