**Reference Volume I, Page 74, Section 4.4.1, as amended, entitled, "Non-Ionizing Electromagnetic Radiation Restrictions" first paragraph.** Delete the first paragraph in its entirety and replace with the following noted with strikeout and bold:

All sites whether existing or proposed shall be designed, protected, **operated** and posted by the SI to limit exposure to Electromagnetic Emissions (EME) in accordance with ~~47 CFR all Federal Regulations, including but not limited to, 47 CFR, as revised and 29 CFR (Sections 1904, 1910 and 1926), as revised Federal Communications Commissions (FCC) OET (office of Engineering and Technology) Bulletin OET 65 (Appendix D or most recent regulation adopted by the FCC), the Federal Communications Commissions exposure to Radio Frequency Electromagnetic Emissions (RF EME), and the Commonwealth of Virginia (COV) RF Radiation Exposure Compliance Plan (refer to Appendix K), as revised.~~ **The most current version of the Commonwealth of Virginia RF Radiation Exposure Compliance Plan can be obtained from the Virginia Department of Technology Planning or its website <http://www.dtp.state.va.us>.**

**Reference Volume I, Page 79, Section 4.6, entitled “Interference”, third paragraph.** Delete the third paragraph in its entirety and replace with the following noted with strikeout and bold:

**In both Scenario 1 and 2, the Offeror ~~it will~~ shall describe in their proposal how mutual radio interference will be corrected** ~~be the responsibility of the SI to correct mutual radio interference between this system and any other system within the COV, which is installed, and in operation at Contract award. System acceptance, for each phase, will not occur until all interference issues are corrected.~~ ~~In Scenario 2, it shall be the responsibility of the SI to correct mutual radio interference between this system and any other co-located system which is installed and in operation as of the Proposal due date.~~

Signature on this addendum does not constitute your signature on the original proposal document. The original proposal document must be signed also.
