Virginia Critical Operation for a Disappeared Child Initiative (CODI) Alert Program

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<u>Virginia Critical Operation for a Disappeared Child Initiative Alert Program</u>

1. Purpose

a. The Virginia Critical Operation for a Disappeared Child Initiative (CODI) Alert Program is an alert system designed to efficiently inform the public of information regarding a missing child whose disappearance poses a credible threat, as determined by a law enforcement investigation. The Virginia State Police has established the following standards and procedures by which a law-enforcement agency shall verify that a child is critically missing and submit an alert request.

2. Definitions

- a. "Missing or endangered child" means a child (i) who is 17 years of age or younger or is currently enrolled in a secondary school in the Commonwealth, regardless of age; (ii) whose whereabouts are unknown; and (iii) whose disappearance is under suspicious circumstances or poses a credible threat as determined by law enforcement to the safety and health of the child and under such other circumstances as deemed appropriate by the Virginia State Police.
- b. "Critical Operation for a Disappeared Child Initiative Alert" or "Codi Alert" means the notice of a missing or endangered child provided to the public by the media or other methods under a CODI Agreement.

- c. "Critical Operation for a Disappeared Child Initiative Agreement" or "CODI Agreement" means the voluntary agreement between law-enforcement officials and members of the media whereby a child will be declared missing or endangered and the public will be notified, and includes all other incidental conditions of the partnership as found appropriate by the Virginia State Police.
- d. "Critical Operation for a Disappeared Child Initiative Alert Program" or "CODI Alert Program" or "Program" means the procedures and CODI Agreements to aid in the identification and location of missing or endangered children.
- e. "Media" means print, radio, television, and internet-based communication systems or other methods of communicating information to the public.

Criteria for Activation of the Alert

Each law enforcement agency shall investigate the matter to verify the disappearance, and eliminate alternative explanations where evidence is lacking. Information must be established to meet the definition of a missing or endangered child. Also, sufficient information must be available to disseminate to the public to assist in locating the missing child, to include a vehicle if there is one, in order to activate the alert.

- a. Elements for a missing or endangered child
 - i. Any person 17 years of age or younger or is currently enrolled in a secondary school in the Commonwealth;
 - ii. Whose whereabouts are unknown, and;
 - iii. Whose disappearance is under suspicious circumstances or poses a credible threat as determined by law enforcement to the safety and health of the child, or;
 - iv. Based on any other circumstances as deemed appropriate by the Virginia State Police.

4. Alert Components

- a. Virginia Criminal Information Network (VCIN)
 - i. VCIN is a telecommunication system which provides 24-hour access to Virginia law enforcement agencies to enter and query criminal justice information, including information concerning missing persons.
- b. Virginia Missing Persons Clearinghouse (VMPC)
 - i. The Clearinghouse is operated by the Virginia State Police and provides the public with information regarding missing persons through the Virginia

Missing Persons website. Additionally, the VMPC utilizes Everbridge software; a public notification and warning platform capable of disseminating messages to the media and other partners.

- 5. Activation Procedure for Investigating Law Enforcement Agency
 - a. Enter the missing child into the Virginia Criminal Information Network (VCIN) and the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) missing person files.
 - b. Complete the SP-183 (*Virginia Missing Children Information Clearinghouse Report* Obtain a form at: https://vsp.virginia.gov/services/forms/#Missing) and email it to the Virginia Missing Persons Clearinghouse at vamissing@vsp.virginia.gov.
 - c. Complete the Virginia CODI Alert Activation Request Form (Obtain a form at https://vsp.virginia.gov/law-enforcement-users-guides/).
 - i. Should you have any questions or concerns about whether your situation is appropriate for a CODI Alert, you may contact the duty sergeant at 804-674-2026.
 - ii. Attach a current photograph of the missing child.
 - iii. Attach the completed SP-183.
 - iv. Designate a department point of contact who is available to discuss the Alert request and provide their contact information (name and telephone number).
 - d. Email the CODI Alert Activation Request Form, the SP-183, the agency point of contact, and any photographs or supplemental information to the duty sergeant at dutysgthq@vsp.virginia.gov.
 - i. Contact the duty sergeant at 804-674-2026 to confirm receipt of the packet information, or if you have any difficulties transmitting information.
 - e. As additional information becomes available, including photographs, the investigating law enforcement agency shall contact the duty sergeant immediately with updates so the information can be disseminated appropriately.

6. Cancellation Procedure

a. Upon locating a child who is the subject of a CODI Alert, the investigating law enforcement agency shall immediately notify the Virginia State Police duty sergeant at dutysgthq@vsp.virginia.gov to cancel the request.

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

Activation
Investigate the matter to verify the disappearance, confirming they are critically missing and eliminate alternative explanations.
Enter the missing child into the Virginia Criminal Information Network (VCIN) and the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) missing person files.
Complete the SP-183 (Virginia Missing Children Information Clearinghouse Report) and email it to the Virginia Missing Persons Clearinghouse at vamissing@vsp.virginia.gov.
Complete the Virginia CODI Alert Activation Request Form.
 Attach a current photograph of the missing or endangered child. Attach the completed SP-183. Designate a department contact with information who is available to discuss the alert request (include a name and telephone number). Provide sufficient information to disseminate to the public to assist in locating the missing adult.
Email the Virginia CODI Alert Activation Request Form, the SP-183 and any photographs to the duty sergeant at dutysgthq@vsp.virginia.gov.
Contact the duty sergeant at 804-674-2026 to confirm receipt of the packet information or if you should have any difficulties transmitting information.
Update/Cancel Alert
Updated alert information needs to be sent to dutysgthq@vsp.virginia.gov.
Immediately notify the duty sergeant at dutysgthq@vsp.virginia.gov with the cancellation request.
Contact the duty sergeant by phone to confirm the receipt of the cancellation request.
Contact the Duty Sergeant by phone if you have questions Call 804-674-2026.

- 10. Virginia State Police Internal Handling Procedures
 - a. Upon receiving a request from a law enforcement agency to activate a CODI Alert, the duty sergeant will review the information to ensure the criteria is met.
 - b. The duty sergeant will notify the VCIN First Sergeant, or designee, who will evaluate the request and determine if a CODI Alert should be activated. The reviewing supervisor will notify the duty sergeant of the decision.
 - c. The duty sergeant shall enter all Alert requests into the Front Desk application.
 - d. While CODI Alerts are ongoing, the file shall be kept in a centralized location and updated frequently. Duty sergeants are to maintain periodic communication with the investigating agency to monitor the status of active Alerts.
 - e. Once the CODI Alert has been cancelled, duty sergeants will update the Front Desk entry, and forward a copy of the following paperwork to the Virginia Missing Persons Clearinghouse for record retention:
 - i. Activation Form
 - ii. SP-183
 - iii. After Action Report
 - iv. Any other notes/documentation pertaining to the alert
